

# Swanton, Wauseon Win Championships

ARCHBOLD—Swanton and Wauseon walked away with the Northern Border and Northwest Ohio Athletic League cross country championships here Thursday.

Swanton easily retained the NBL title it won a year ago while Wauseon had little trouble in disposing previous champion Napoleon in the NWOAL.

Swanton had 31 points while Wauseon was second with 43 points in the NBL. Other finishes were: Liberty Center 72, Archbold 108, Patrick Henry 143, Delta 158, Montpelier 162 and Evergreen 250.

Wauseon had 38 points to win the NWOAL with Bryan coming in second with 52 points. Liberty with 61, Archbold with 101, Napoleon with 103 and Montpelier with 146 rounded out the

group.

Wauseon's Mark Warfield was the individual winner in both meets, circling the two-mile course in 9:33.

In the NBL, Swanton's Naaman Thomas, Jerry Underwood and Dany Cooley came in second, third and fourth. Wauseon's Dave O'Brien was fifth while Liberty's Brad Meister was sixth. Rosendo Gomez and Jeff Oberla of Wauseon were seventh and eighth while Montpelier's George Ring and Swanton's Dale Timpe were ninth and tenth.

Bryan's Ron Hazlett was second to Warfield in the NWOAL race. Napoleon's Jeff Rabe was fourth and Wauseon's O'Brien was fifth. Liberty's Meister and Gomez and Oberla of Wauseon were fifth through seventh while Montpeliers Ring and Bryan's Rob Rowan and Ton McCarns closed out the top ten.
