

Golfers of DHS Win League Title In Napoleon Play

Defiance High took the Northwest Ohio League golf championship with a team score of 544 in a meet Wednesday at Napoleon.

The Naps, defending champions, were second with 546 strokes and Montpelier third with 594. Bryan, which brought only four men, automatically was ranked fourth, with a 444 total.

The second-placers put three boys ahead of any of the Bulldogs, but their fifth and sixth contestants got such low scores that the Wildcats' total was dragged below Defiance's.

Scores for Coach J. G. Demyan's DHS linksmen were Wayne McCoy and Arley Frisinger 85's, Ronnie Williams 86, Junior Mohr 95, Allen Ryan 96 and Ken Neff 97.

Napoleon's scores were Selhorst and Bernicke 80's, Wirauch 82, Taylor 92 and Rogers and Hurst 106's.

The league offers no awards for the meet, but the DHS athletic board will give the team a trophy and individual medals, and a spot in the Bulldog Hall of Fame will be assigned.
