

BRYAN DEFEATS NAPS TO ANNEX CHAMPIONSHIP

Bryan, Nov. 29.—Bryan high school today reigns supreme for 1935 in the Northwest Ohio High School Athletic League as the result of whipping Napoleon, 13 to 0, here Thursday.

Entering the game as the underdogs, Bryan stopped the highly touted running attack of the Little Corporals, and then scored in the third and fourth periods to gain the league championship, a position that Defiance had held four years.

More than 2,000 fans witnessed the decisive battle.

Bryan's line was outstanding. Three times Napoleon was stopped inside the ten-yard line.

Impton scored Bryan's first touchdown in the third quarter on a 15-yard run. Ridenour was intercepted a pass and raced 70 yards for the other touchdown at the opening of the final period. Impton converted. Small's punting featured.
