

# BULLDOGS GAIN THREE PLACES ON ALL-LEAGUE

Three Defiance high school cagers—all juniors—were named to the annual sports writers Northwest Ohio Athletic league team it was announced today.

They are John Rosendale and the Seiple twins, Carrol and Darrol. Neil Krauss and Vic Keller, both of Wauseon, make up the remainder of the first five, marking the first time in the history of the selections that only two squads have been represented on the first team.

Clyde Snodgrass of Defiance gained a position on the second team, which also includes Curly Hoffman, of Bryan, Denny Aeschliman of Wauseon, Russ Davis of Liberty Center and Connolly of Montpelier.

Honorable mention went to Walter Bartel, Liberty Center; Garwood Hardy, Bryan; John Bost, Napoleon; Jr. Bratton, Montpelier; Max Minnich, Napoleon, and Ely, Montpelier.

It was the first time that Defiance has so dominated the all-league team. That they are worthy of the honor was seen in their championship record of 10 wins without defeat while all other league teams suffered at least three losses. Defiance placed only two in the all-league when they won their last championship in 1940 and only one last year.

Rosendale and the two Seiples received honorable mention last season while sophomores.
