

Derricotte Leads League's Scoring

Football scoring title of the Northwest Ohio Athletic league, which went last year to Vern Snyder, was won by Defiance again this season as Gene Derricotte finished far out in front of the pack with 70 points in loop games.

That was 26 points better than his nearest competitor, Roger Ely of Montpelier, who had 44. Watkins of Wauseon was third with 26 and Earl Fry of Defiance, fourth with 19. Conrad of Liberty Center and Robison of Wauseon, with 18 points apiece, were the only other gridgers to score more than two touchdowns in circuit play.
