

Ely Scores 55 For Montpelier To Lead League

Halfback Chet Ely of Montpelier galloped off with Northwest Ohio League scoring honors for the 1950 season, with 55 points acquired by way of nine touchdowns and one extra point.

His nearest challenger was Liberty Center Center Halfback Gail Burdue, whose total was 44. Defiance's top man was Halfback Bob Ankney with 29.

Montpelier carted off team scoring honors with 131 points in its five NWOL skirmishes. Napoleon was only three behind with 128. The Locomotives also were tops defensively, holding foes to 38 tallies. Defiance took second in this department with 64.
