

100-Yard Run Features Final Indian Defeat

Wauseon, Nov. 16—A hundred-yard run by Marvin Stoll in the second quarter gave Wauseon her only score here Friday night in a football game won by Delta, 26 to 6.

Stoll intercepted a pass in his own end zone and eluded Delta tacklers until dropped on the Delta 3-yard line. He plunged across on the second play.

The victors led all the way, scoring one touchdown in the first period, three in the fourth, and converting two extra points. McQuillen scored two of Delta's touchdowns on plunges and passed 35 yards to Zeigler for another.

Shelt, Delta halfback, suffered a broken leg in scoring the visitors' final touchdown by a line buck on the last play of the game.

This was the last of Wauseon's ten-game schedule, all defeats.
