

DEFIANCE IS NOT MEMBER OF HIGH SCHOOL LEAGUE

Because newspapers in towns where the high schools are members of the recently organized Northwest Ohio Athletic League persist in publishing Defiance high school in the weekly standing, Principal B. M. Lindemuth of the high school, today was asked what this is all about.

"Defiance has never been represented at any of their meetings and is not a member of the league," Principal Lindemuth replied. "We are not opposed to the league and are on friendly terms with these schools. Although we do not belong we play most of the league schools during the season.

"Our objection to enrolling in the organization is that we would have to play a required number of games with the other members of the league and consequently might not be able to schedule such schools as Van Wert and others to the south of us with whom we desire to maintain athletic relations."
