Selgo rewrites records

TOLEDO—Tim Selgo, of Pettisville, should have his name permanently imprinted in the University of Toledo and Mid-American Conference record books for a long time. Selgo holds or shares seven different records.

Selgo set the UT and MAC records for highest free throw percentage in all games of a career, .861. The old UT mark was .812 by John Brisker in 1966-69 and the old MAC record was .845 by Howard Komives, 1962-64.

Selgo set the UT record for highest free throw percentage in career league games, .839 while the old mark was .811 by Jim Ray, 1954-56.

Selgo set the UT mark for highest free throw percentage in one league season, .917 as the old mark was .875 by Willie Babione in 1967-68.

Selgo set the UT record for most assists in one league season, 109 while the old mark was 95 by Dave Speicher, 1975-76.

Selgo set the UT record for most minutes played in one season, 1,023 while the old mark was 923 by Stan Joplin.
