Bill McGrath, a guard, who was placed on the second all-Northwest Ohio Athletic League team, was the only 1932-1933 Defiance high school basketball player honored by the Home Radio Service which selected first and second teams with the assistance of two Napoleon newspaper men, Mel Minnich of the Northwest News, and Em. Mann of the Henry County Signal.
